This contract involves the rehabilitation of the existing pavement for the following streets, which are located in the Columbia Tusculum, Downtown, Hyde Park, Kennedy Heights, Linwood and Northside area of Cincinnati:

- a. Columbia Parkway: Maintain two 11' lanes of traffic inbound and one outbound between 6 a.m. and 9 a.m., Monday through Friday. Maintain two 11' lanes of traffic outbound and one inbound between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m., Monday through Friday. During all other working hours, one 10' lane of traffic in each direction shall be maintained. During all non-working hours, the roadway shall be open and available for the movement of traffic. An off duty Police Officer and cruiser shall be on site to assist with traffic movement while working in or within 50 ft. of the signalized intersection.
- b. Stanley Avenue between Kellogg Avenue and Columbia Parkway: Roadway must be fully open and available to traffic in both directions between 7 a.m. and 9 a.m., and between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. Monday through Friday, and during all non-working hours. During all other working hours, one 11-foot lane in each direction shall be maintained. An off duty Police Officer and cruiser shall be on site to assist with traffic movement while working in or within 50 ft. of the signalized intersection.

- c. Stanley Avenue between Columbia Parkway and Handman Avenue:
During all working hours, one 11 ft. lane shall be open and available to traffic. Flagging shall be necessary. During all non-working hours, the roadways shall be open and available for the movement of traffic. PROPERTY ACCESS SHALL BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES.
- d. West Sixth Street between Race Street and Rusconi Place:
During the week – Monday through Friday – work may only be performed from 6 p.m. to 11 p.m., at which time one 12’ travel lane must remain open. On weekends, work may only be performed from 6 a.m. to 11 p.m., at which time two 10’ travel lanes must remain open. In addition, the entire roadway must be open. In addition the entire roadway must be open and available for traffic beginning two hours prior to and until one hour after any special event or other activity scheduled by the City Of Cincinnati.
- e. Linwood Ave.: One 10’ lane of traffic in each direction shall be maintained. During all non-working hours, the roadway shall be open and available for the movement of traffic.

All Other Streets: During all working hours, the roadways may be closed. During all non-working hours, the roadways shall be open and available for the movement of traffic. PROPERTY AND EMERGENCY ACCESS SHALL BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES.

Project involves rehabilitation of various streets in Fairmount and Mt Auburn. The project will start on June 21, 2004 and expected to be completed in December, 2004. See below for the streets that will be rehab and traffic restrictions of the streets.

- A. On the following streets, during all working hours, the roadway may be closed. During all non-working hours, open the entire roadway to traffic. Maintain property access at all times:

1. Amor Pl. from South Terminus to Westwood Ave.
 2. Klotter Ave. from Renner Pl. to Ravine St.
 3. Montrose St. from Harrison Ave. to Lima St.
 4. Rankin Ave. from Queen City Ave. to North Terminus
 5. Renner Pl. from South Terminus to Klotter Ave.
 6. Waveland Pl. from Knox St. to North Terminus
 7. Wickham Pl. from Engel Alley to Queen City Ave.
- B. On the following streets, during all working hours, maintain two-way traffic. Utilize Flagging procedures. During all non-working hours, open the entire roadway to traffic:
1. Bloom St. from Waverly Ave. to Knox St.
 2. Ernst Ave. from State Ave. to Hiawatha Ave.
 3. Fairmount Ave. from Beekman St. to Liddell St.
 4. Sutter Ave. from Beekman St. to Bleecker Ln.
 5. Tremont Ave. from Beekman St. to Harrison Ave.
- C. On McHenry Ave., from Harrison Ave. to 200' North, keep one ten-foot (10') lane in each direction open to traffic at all times.
- D. On Harrison Ave @ McHenry only close the right lanes Friday through Monday to facilitate bus pad installation. Open the lanes Monday by 7AM.
- E. On Baltimore Ave. from President Dr. to Montana Ave. and on Westwood Northern Blvd and Sutter Ave., between the hours of 7-9 AM & 4-6 PM (Mon. thru Fri.), and during all non-working hours, open the entire roadway to traffic. During all working hours, open one ten-foot (10') lane in each direction for traffic.
- F. On Westwood Ave. from Moellering Ave. to Selim Ave. between the hours of 6-9 AM (Mon. thru Fri.), and during all non-working hours, open the entire roadway to traffic. During all other hours, open two ten-foot (10') lanes eastbound for the movement of traffic. NOTE: Utilize a uniformed City of Cincinnati police officer at all major intersections.

- A. On Hereford St. from East Terminus to Burns Ave., during all working hours, the roadway may be closed. During all non-working hours, open the roadway to traffic. Maintain property access at all times.
- B. On Woodsdale Ave. from Burns Ave to Vine St., and on Woodbine Ave. from Parkway Ave. to Millsdale St., during all working hours, maintain two-way traffic. Utilize flagging procedures. During all non-working hours, open the roadway to traffic.

The following restriction on local roadways shall apply to the construction involved in the project:

- a. On Kirby Rd., from North Bend Rd. to Ashtree Dr., the road may be closed at the actual work site. "Road Closed to Thru Traffic" may be installed at the point of detour for all affected streets. The contractor shall erect and maintain a signed detour approved by the Project Engineer. Local access shall be maintained. Arrangements shall be made with Police, Fire and affected residents to establish the actual point of physical closure on a daily basis.
